The preceding verse is very difficult to follow when a person is enduring a lengthy trial. After I was diagnosed with hydrocephalus, an abnormal accumulation of cerebrospinal fluid in the ventricles of the brain, my local neurologist made an appointment for me with a neurologist in Philadelphia. That was about seven weeks ago. On September 16 at Hahnenann Hospital in Philadelphia, I will be having an operation to relieve the pressure in my brain by having a spinal tap. There is a possibility that I will have another operation for a shunt system to be installed to divert the flow of the cerebrospinal fluid to where it can be adsorbed as part of the normal circulatory process. September 16 will be four months and three days after I first went to my family doctor for assistance and eight months after seeing my cardiologist.

Did God forsake me during this time? The answer is no! When I was down and felt that I could not go on, He carried me. When I felt alone, He held me in His arms. Through emails, letters and phone calls, I know that there are people praying for me in the states of Pennsylvania, Maryland, Ohio, Virginia, Illinois, Oklahoma and Florida and also in the nation of Kenya. Most of these people I did not know before I started prayer walking across America. After the operation, I should regain my normal mental and physical abilities. Keep me in your prayers.
